The Sacrament of Penance (Cont . . .)

Certainly, God forgives our sins if we sincerely seek God's pardon in prayer. The sacrament of penance offers us a special way of mending our relationship with God and with the church which may have been broken or damaged by our sinfulness. Our reconciliation with the church strengthens our relationship with God and enables us to enjoy the gifts God offers through the church. While we are not strictly obliged to sacramental reconciliation unless we have committed serious sin, it is good for us and good for the church if we present ourselves regularly to the church community, acknowledging our sinfulness and continuing need of God's grace and the support of the church. As the ordained minister and representative of the church, the priest receives our confession and acts in the name of Christ in the church in granting absolution and reconciliation with God's people. We are assured of God's love and forgiveness and encouraged to live more like Christ in the Church. The effects of this sacrament are seen in lives that are reconciled and reconciling.

The Rite of Penance

In its concern for all people in the many and varied circumstances of their lives, the church provides a range of opportunities within which to respond to God's invitation to mercy and forgiveness. The sacrament of penance has 3 rites for reconciliation although only the first two are regularly used. There is a general pattern common to the three rites:

- Introductory Rites
- Word of God
- Confession and Acceptance of Penance
- Prayer of Contrition and Absolution
- Proclamation of Praise and Dismissal

The introductory rites may be a simple but warm greeting in Rite I, or a psalm or a hymn in Rite II, followed by a greeting. In both instances it will aim to build confidence in God's loving mercy.

The celebration of the word of God is an important part of the liturgy. In the sacrament of penance it helps priest and penitent to focus on God's mercy and the call to conversion. It reminds them to be open to the action of God in the sacrament.

The Rite of Penance (Cont . . .)

It is necessary to confess any grave sin, but penitents are free to mention other areas of sinfulness which they are concerned about. It is always good to look more deeply, not only at what we do wrong, but why we do it. This helps us to look below the surface and address, with God's help, the roots of the problem.

After the confession the priest gives a penance which is normally linked to some aspect of the confession, and which somehow represents the change of attitude or direction in life required by the sacrament. It may take the form of prayer, self-denial, or especially some kind of service or work of mercy. This underlines that sin and its forgiveness have a communal aspect in the church and society as well as a personal one.

The penitent makes a prayer of contrition, with the intention of beginning a new life, and asking for God's pardon. This may be a set formula, of which a number are suggested in the rite, or be the penitent's own words. It is desirable that the prayer be based on the words of scripture (Rite of Penance #19). Some parishes offer a selection of prayers from the rite which may be used.
