### ***The Rite of Penance*** (*Cont . . .*)

The Introduction to the rite makes this comment:

This form of absolution indicates that the reconciliation of the penitent comes from the mercy of the Father; it shows the connection between the reconciliation of the sinner and the paschal mystery of Christ; it stresses the role of the Holy Spirit in the forgiveness of sins; finally it underlines the ecclesial aspect of the sacrament because reconciliation with God is asked for and given through the ministry of the church.

*The Rite of Penance* # 19

The celebration of the sacrament ends with proclamation of praise and thanksgiving, and a dismissal such as "The Lord has freed you from your sins. Go in peace."

### ***Rite 1: For Reconciliation of an Individual***

Parishes have one or more reconciliation rooms or chapels, which provide an appropriate environment for this rite, and are arranged to offer a choice of facing the priest or remaining anonymous.

Both priest and penitent are encouraged to prepare for the celebration of the liturgy by prayer and the reading of the scripture. After the greeting, the word of God may be introduced by the priest or the penitent.

After the penitent's confession, the priest may offer some comments to help the person make the changes needed to turn away from sin and follow Christ more faithfully. But the sacrament of reconciliation is not for extended counselling. If it seems necessary, the priest may encourage the penitent to follow up the sacramental celebration with some counselling at another time.

The prayer of contrition is followed by an acceptance of the penance given by the priest. Absolution is then given using the words and gesture mentioned above.

A proclamation of praise and thanksgiving is followed by a simple dismissal.

***Rite II: For Several Penitents with Individual Confession and Absolution***

This celebration of the sacrament uses the main worship space in the church and often takes place during the seasons of Lent and Advent, or on a more regular basis. It may take place with a small group and one priest or in a larger assembly with a number of priests. The rite shows more clearly the social nature of sin and forgiveness and that the sacrament is an action of the whole body of Christ. The usual elements of a parish liturgical celebration are included: various ministries, such as music, readers and leaders of prayer; communal prayer; and so on.

***Introductory Rites***

The rite begins with an appropriate gathering song, a greeting and the opening prayer.

***Celebration of the Word***

There is one or more readings from scripture through which God calls us to repentance and conversion. If there is only one reading, it is preferable that it is from one of the gospels. When there is more than one reading they should be separated by a psalm or period of silence to reflect upon the word of God more deeply and assent to it. The reading of the scriptures is followed by the homily, based on them and leading those gathered to examination of conscience and renewal of life.

**07 Sunday**

## **Rite II: For Several Penitents with Individual Confession and Absolution** *(Cont . . .)*

### **Rite of Reconciliation**

This part of the rite begins with general confession, such as the, 'I confess...' followed by a litany or appropriate song and concluding with the Lord's prayer. Individual confession and absolution then take place. If the group is large, several priests are usually available at various places in the body of the church, since it is not appropriate to use the reconciliation chapel for this rite. Penitents individually approach a priest of their choice, confess their sins, accept a penance and receive absolution. During this time appropriate music may be played or songs sung, or prayers recited by the assembly. When confessions are over, the presiding priest invites all to join in thanksgiving for God's great mercy.

### ***Rite III: For Several Penitents with General Confession and Absolution***

This rite follows the pattern of Rite II, but with confession and absolution being general instead of individual, and with an instruction added to or included in the homily, about the appropriate requirements for receiving absolution. The bishop of the diocese is to make the judgement about when the conditions set out by the church for the use of this rite are met, and he is to agree with criteria for using this with the other bishops of the episcopal conference.

#### ***Penitential Services***

Prayer services which focus on the gospel and on God's great mercy and loving forgiveness, are also a fruitful way of bringing God's people to greater faithfulness in following Christ. Such penitential services often follow the structure of Rite II, but without confessions and absolution. The different significance of a penitential service from the celebration of the sacrament of penance needs to be made very clear (see Rite of Penance, #36-37).
