CHURCH MUSIC COPYRIGHT ADMINISTRATION AND MANAGEMENT

The New Zealand Catholic Bishops sponsored an exceptionally successful national seminar on the topic of Church Music Copyright place in June this year. Representatives from each of the six dioceses attended. Now these teams are preparing educational resources and copyright information to ensure parishes, schools and religious communities are copyright compliant.

Consider these 3 key questions: Do you copy music? Project lyrics? Create worship aids? If the answer to any one of these questions is yes, then legally, you need a copyright license to do so.
