LOW GLUTEN HOSTS

Coeliac condition is an adverse reaction to gliadin, a protein present in gluten. The Coeliac Society estimates that 1 in 70 or about 60,000 to 70,000 New Zealanders have the disease. In larger communities there will often be one or two families afflicted with this disease, therefore very special care has to be taken for those in our community. The National Liturgy Office has released guidelines for the pastoral care of people who are gluten intolerant.
