Pastoral Notes: There are three alternative Masses for today.

- A selection of the readings for this Commemoration is given in Volume 1 (L1:966) of the Lectionary. The complete readings are given in Volume 3 (L3:849ff), see Masses for the Dead. The priest is encouraged to select the most appropriate readings from the full selection in that place.
- A Priest may celebrate or concelebrate three Masses on All Souls' Day, as long as the Masses occur at different times of the day. (GIRM 204).
- If a Priest celebrates more than one Mass during All Souls' Day, the second Mass is to be offered for the Souls of All the Faithful Departed and the third Mass for the intentions of the Pope. No offerings may be received for either of these two Masses.
- November is a special month in which we are encouraged to pray for the dead.
- A plenary indulgence may be gained for the dead, once only, by visiting a church on 2 November and praying the Lord's Prayer and the Creed. Three conditions are required for the gaining of the indulgence:
  - sacramental confession
  - Holy Communion
  - prayer for the Pope's intentions

# LLOW THE SYMBOLS TO SPEAK

П

Especially in celebrations like the sacrament of baptism, in which people participate only occasionally, the temptation is to explain the meaning of a sign of symbol beforehand. This immediately reduces the power of the symbol to speak to the assembly. It limits its meaning to the words of explanation. Effective ritual allows the symbol to speak for itself. This required faith in the power of the symbol on the part of the leader, thoughtful and eloquent presentation of the rites, and trust that the people gathered will be attentive and responsive to what they see, hear and touch. If comment or discussion seems appropriate, let it happen after the completion of the rites.

# A LLOW THE SYMBOLS TO SPEAK

All the symbols of the initiation rites invite close scrutiny and reflection, leading to greater appreciation of their hidden treasures. The more the Christian community celebrates these rites with careful respect for the symbols, the more people's understanding of initiation will grow. This will not happen where people place too much importance on practical issues, such as how long the rites take, or how convenient and comfortable the rites are for the participants. Nor does it help when people think all that matters is that the sacraments are celebrated. In the sacred rites of the church, is it not the case of what you do; it is the way you do it too.
